### 1 PROCEEDINGS 2 MR. TREVIÑO: Can you guys hear me? VOICES: Yes. 3 MR. TREVIÑO: Okay. Here we go. 4 5 Good morning. My name is Memo Treviño, 6 chairman of this subcommittee, and I'm pleased to open the 7 Personnel Subcommittee meeting of the board of the Texas 8 Department of Motor Vehicles. 9 Will all board members please make sure their 10 video is turned on throughout the meeting, and use their unmute button prior to speaking. 11 It is 10:00 a.m., and I'm now calling the 12 13 Personnel Subcommittee meeting for November 17, 2020 to 14 order. 15 I want to note for the record that the public 16 notice of this meeting containing all items on the agenda 17 was filed with the Office of Secretary of State on November 9, 2020. 18 Before we begin today's meeting, please place 19 all cell phones and other communication devices into 20 silent mode, and please, as a courtesy to others, do not 21 22 carry on side conversations or other activities during the 2.3 conference call. 24 This meeting is being held by telephone

conference call in accordance with Texas Government Code

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Chapter 551, as temporarily modified, under Governor Greg Abbott's authority to suspend certain statutes due to COVID-19.

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Governor Abbott has suspended various provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act that require government officials and members of the public to be physically present at specified meeting locations. Under that suspension, the public will not be able to physically attend this meeting in person.

Instead, the public may attend this meeting by using the link or by calling the toll-free telephone number, which are both posted in our agenda which was filed with the Office of Secretary of State on November 9, 2020.

All Committee members, including myself, will be participating remotely via Webex. At this time, please mute your phone for the entire duration of this meeting.

I am asking our Webex meeting host to make sure all participants' phones are muted and that their video is turned off except for committee members and those who are presenting.

Callers will be removed for any disruption including background noise. I would like to remind all participants that this is a telephone conference call meeting. Because this meeting is being held by telephone

Member Bacarisse is not present. 4 5 Member Prewitt? 6 MR. PREWITT: Here, sir. 7 MR. TREVIÑO: Okay. Let the record reflect 8 that I, Memo Treviño, am also here, and we have a quorum. 9 so we have Member Prewitt is here, and Member Bacarisse 10 is absent. BEAVER: This is Tracey Beaver, General 8 Counsel, for the record, and it is approximately 10:42 9 a.m., and the board is now back in open session. 10 You may begin, Chairman, when you're ready. MR. TREVIÑO: Thank you, Ms. Beaver, and it is 11 approximately 10:43 a.m., and the board of the Texas DMV 12 13 is now back in open session. 14 Will board members please turn on your video 15 and unmute your lines. I ask that the meeting host move 16 Tracey Beaver to panelist. We will now move on to agenda item 4 from the 17 closed session. Are there any questions on this item? 18 19 MS. 22	for, zero against, and the motion carries unanimously.
23	Okay. So well done everyone. Thank you for
