3 §217.144. Identification Number Inspection.

4 In addition to any other requirement specified by Transportation Code, §501.0321, a person is
5 qualified to perform an inspection under Transportation Code, §501.0321, [~~Transportation Code,~~] if that
6 person has completed one of the following training programs:

7 (1) Intermediate or Advanced Motor Vehicle Crime [~~Burglary and Theft~~] Investigator
8 Training provided by the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority [~~Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft~~
9 ~~Prevention Authority~~];

10 (2) Auto Theft School (Parts 1 and 2) provided by the Texas Department of Public Safety;

11 or

12 (3) Auto Theft Course provided by the National Insurance Crime Bureau.

13 **CERTIFICATION.** The agency certifies that legal counsel has reviewed the proposal and found it to be
14 within the state agency's legal authority to adopt.
