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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	MR. RICHARDS: Good morning. My name is David
3	Richards, and I'm pleased to open the first meeting of the
4	Household Goods Rules Advisory Committee. I'm the
5	Associate General Counsel of the Texas Department of Motor
6	Vehicles.
7	For ease of reference, I will refer to this
8	Advisory Committee as HGRAC, which is an acronym for this
9	Committee. It is now 9:02 a.m., and I am calling the
10	HGRAC meeting for February 27, 2024, to order. I want to
11	note for the record that the public notice of this
12	meeting, containing all items on the agenda, was filed
13	with the Office of the Secretary of State on February 16,
14	2024.
15	This meeting is being held by telephone
16	conference call in accordance with Texas Government Code
17	Section 551.125. Members of the public may physically
18	attend this meeting in person at 4000 Jackson Avenue,
19	Building One, Lone Star Conference Room, Austin, Texas,
20	78731, or they may attend this meeting by calling the toll
21	free number, which was posted in our agenda. We have
22	let's see, two members in person, with the rest the
23	majority of this quorum that are participating remotely.
24	At this time, will all attendees please mute
25	your phone for the entire duration of this meeting. I am
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asking our meeting host to make sure all participants' 1 2 phones are muted, except for Advisory Committee members and those who are presenting. Callers will be removed for 3 any disruption, including background noise. 4 5 I would like to remind all participants that 6 this is a telephone conference call. Because this meeting 7 is being held by conference call, there are a few things that will assist in making the meeting run smoother and 8 9 assist our court reporter in obtaining an accurate record. 10 First, please identify yourself before speaking. Second, speak clearly. Remember that there may 11 12 be a slight delay, due to the conference call format. So 13 please wait a little bit longer than usual before 14 responding to participants. 15 Do not speak over others. Please ask the 16 presiding officer to proceed, and make sure you get 17 recognized before speaking. Finally, for members who are participating in 18 19 the room, please remember to press the button on your microphone to unmute before speaking. Then press the same 20 21 button to mute the microphone again, after speaking. 22 At this time, I would like to also thank our 23 court reporter who is transcribing this meeting. 24	Members, we have a quorum. Thank you very
25	much.
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We are going to move on in the agenda to Item 1 2 1B, which is welcoming remarks and introduction of 3 Advisory Committee members. And at this time, I will turn 4 the meeting over to the TxDMV Executive Director, Daniel 5 Avitia. 6 Dan. 7 MR. AVITIA: Thank you, David. 8 Good morning, everyone, and welcome. My name 9 is Daniel Avitia, and I have the pleasure of serving as 10 the Department's Executive Director. Thank you again for taking the time today to be a part of this introductory 11 12 Advisory Committee meeting. Before we continue with the introductions on 13 14 the agenda, I want to provide you with some background 15 information on this particular advisory committee. To 16 begin with, Transportation Code 643.155 requires the 17 Department to appoint an advisory committee to review rules that protect consumers of household good motor 18 19 carriers. 20 This Advisory Committee makes recommendations 21 to the Department and the Board on modernizing and 22 streamlining these rules. The statute requires that the 23 Advisory Committee must be made up of representatives from 24 motor carriers representing household goods using small, 25 medium, and large equipment; the public; and the TxDMV ON THE RECORD REPORTING

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1 staff.

2	Some of you may recall that the Customer
3	Service and Protection Advisory Committee was previously
4	charged with performing this work. In October of '23, the
5	TxDMV Board adopted rules to create a standalone advisory
6	committee known as the Household Goods Advisory Committee.
7	The focus of this Advisory Committee is to advise the
8	Board and the Department on rules regulating motor
9	carriers transporting household goods.
10	We always welcome your input, your honesty, and
11	your ideas. I cannot express to you enough how much I
12	appreciate all of your time and all of your effort as we
13	move forward through this process. Please note that our
14	staff and I are here to help with whatever information you
15	need, whatever we can make available to you.
16	So once again, I appreciate you being here. I
17	appreciate those of you watching. And I notice one of you
18	is driving. Be very safe.
19	And I appreciate the time and commitment that
20	you have put forward to help the TxDMV move forward
21	through these processes. Thank you once again.
22	David, back to you, sir.
23	MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, Executive Director
24	Avitia, for your comments and welcoming remarks.
25	Members, we are going to move on in the agenda
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to Agenda Item 2A, purpose, general information, and scope
of the Advisory Committee.

The purpose of HGRAC is to make recommendations 3 4 to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles and our Board on 5 modernizing and streamlining certain rules regarding 6 protections for consumers using the service of motor 7 carriers who are transporting household goods for compensation. No other topics will be discussed by this 8 9 Committee at this time. 10 Excuse me one second. The Committee provides advice, and recommendations only as requested by the Texas 11 12 Department of Motor Vehicles or our Board. 13 I would like to congratulate each of you on 14 your appointment to this Committee by the Board and thank 15 you again for volunteering your valuable time to assist 16 the Department and the Board by serving on this Committee. 17 As appointed members of this Committee, you are subject to both the Open Meetings Act and the Public Information 18 19 Act. First, let me just go over the Open Meetings 20 Act for you, some provisions. The Open Meetings Act 21 provides that all public business shall be performed in 22 That means that any discussions you have public view. 23 regarding the work you perform with this Committee must be 24 done in a properly scheduled and posted open meeting. 25 Members of this Committee can violate state law

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by having a series of discussions on policy issues outside of these Advisory Committees with other members. That is referred to as a walking quorum.

It is important that you refrain from 4 5 discussing Advisory Committee matters with other members 6 outside of the scheduled and posted meetings. This 7 includes avoiding meeting with other members outside of 8 the properly posted open meeting, not calling other 9 members on the phone to discuss Advisory Committee 10 matters, not using social media to discuss matters that are before the Advisory Committee. 11

12 Discussion with other members, even if less 13 than a quorum, outside a properly posted open meeting for 14 the purpose of secret deliberations can violate the Texas 15 Open Meetings Act, which also carries with it criminal 16 penalties. In addition, information exchanged in your 17 role as an Advisory Committee member can be subject to public disclosure, even if that information is on your 18 19 private email, or cell phone.

This is because as Advisory Committee members, information you have regarding matters brought before the Advisory Committee may also subject you to open records laws. Please be aware that any communication that you have regarding this Committee may be required to be disclosed in response to an open records request made by

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1 the public.

2	Finally, in order to ensure the Advisory
3	Committee meetings run smoothly, Advisory Committees elect
4	a Presiding Officer, which is what we will do here,
5	shortly. Presiding Officer is in charge of making sure
6	Roberts Rules of Order are followed to keep the decorum of
7	the meeting.
8	Presiding Officer will open the meeting, much
9	as I did today, and ensure that a quorum of members are
10	present. Presiding Officer makes sure that members make a
11	motion and second the motion before voting, and make sure
12	that no one member has the floor longer than other members
13	who wish to speak or provide input.
14	We will be happy to provide some overview
15	training on the mechanics of Roberts Rules of Order to
16	anyone wanting to volunteer to be Presiding Officer of
17	this Committee, and ensure that it runs efficiently, in
18	carrying out its purpose.
19	Some examples of Roberts Rules of Order are as
20	follows. No member can speak twice to the same issue
21	until everyone else wishing to speak on it has spoken on
22	it once. All remarks by members must be directed to the
23	Presiding Officer prior to speaking.
24	As a member, you obtain the floor by raising
25	your hand or asking the Presiding Officer for the floor or
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the right to speak on a matter, only when the person 1 2 speaking is finished. 3 And finally, it is important not to interrupt 4 others, and to share the right to speak with all members. 5 Remarks must be courteous. And members must avoid 6 referring to viewpoints by alluding to other members by 7 name, or by suggesting motives. 8 As an Advisory Committee member, expect the 9 Presiding Officer to protect your right to speak, even if 10 it turns out that you are a minority of one in your opinion. Presiding Officer helps to ensure that other 11 members hear you out and allow you the same time as 12 13 everyone else on the Committee. This encourages members 14 to give your fellow members their rightful turn to speak. 15 16 Listen to them. You may hear something that 17 affects the way you think, as well. Lastly, we are recording this meeting. 18 So 19 before you speak, please state your name clearly so we 20 have a record of what each person has said. 21 Any questions at this point, before I move on? 22 (No response.) 23 MR. RICHARDS: Hearing none, I will move on to 24 Agenda Item 2B, nominations and selection of Advisory 25 Committee Presiding Officer. Members, Texas law requires ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

the Advisory Committee to select a presiding officer from 1 2 its members. Presiding Officer will preside over the 3 Advisory Committee and report to the TxDMV and our Board. 4 5 Let's have each member, as an introduction, 6 introduce themselves, provide some information on your 7 background, and say for the record whether or not you 8 would be interested in serving as the Presiding Officer of 9 HGRAC. 10 So to that end, let's start with the roll call here again. 11 12 Member Andis, are you with us? 13 (No response.) 14 MR. RICHARDS: Member Andis. 15 (No response.) 16 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Next, Member Baumgartner. 17 Please tell us about yourself and whether you are interested in serving as Presiding Officer. 18 19 MR. BAUMGARTNER: Good morning everyone. My 20 name is Rodney Baumgartner. I am with the Federal Motor 21 Carrier Safety Administration as the state programs 22 manager for the State of Texas. I have been in this 23 position for -- I will start again. I thought it was 24 working. 25 Good morning, everyone. My name is Rodney ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

1 Baumgartner. I am with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety 2 Administration, state programs manager for the Texas 3 Division. Been doing this for 22 years. 4 And I would not be interested in being the 5 Presiding Officer. Thank you. 6 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, Member Baumgartner. 7 Member Briscoe. 8 MR. BRISCOE: Good morning, everybody. 9 MR. RICHARDS: Good morning. 10 MR. BRISCOE: So I have been the Vice President of Operations for Willis Permian Movers, now Texas Moving, 11 12 for the last eleven years. Prior to that, I worked for JB 13 Hunt, doing national account work for them. I would be 14 happy to serve in whatever capacity that I can. 15 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. So that is a possibility, 16 ves? 17 MR. BRISCOE: Yes. 18 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Thank you, Member 19 Briscoe. 20 Member Brooks. 21 MS. BROOKS: Dorothy Brooks. I am a consultant 22 for Southwest Movers Association, after having been a 23 full-time staff member there over 20 years. I am not 24 interested in serving as the Presiding Officer. 25 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, Member Brooks. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

Next, Member Cisneros, are you on the call? 1 2 (No response.) 3 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Member Crockett. MR. CROCKETT: This is Crockett. I am with the 4 5 Garland Police Department. I have 32 years of service. 6 And I am a traffic officer/commercial vehicle 7 enforcement officer. And I have been doing it since 2009. 8 I am not interested in serving as a Board member 9 President. 10 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, Member Crockett, and thank you for your service, as well. 11 Member Ellis. 12 13 MS. ELLIS: Yes, hi. Chelsea Ellis. Ι 14 currently serve as the Vice President of customer 15 development for BBB, serving the Heart of Texas. I have 16 been with the organization for over 15 years. 17 And a majority of my experience and expertise falls in serving not only the business community, but also 18 19 consumers in our 105 county service area. So familiar 20 with the moving industry, as well as the issues that face 21 some consumers in that industry. So I look forward to 22 being of support. And I am not interested in the 23 Presiding Officer opportunity. 24 MR. RICHARDS: Great. Thank you, Member Ellis. 25 Member Hertzberg. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

MR. HERTZBERG: Good morning. I am Christian 1 2 Hertzberg. I am a twelve-year State of Texas employee and 3 a four-year employee of the Texas DMV. I don't want to 4 see this Committee overly weighted with opinions from 5 inside this Agency, so I would like to defer that 6 opportunity. 7 Thank you, Member Hertzberg. MR. RICHARDS: 8 Member McCullah, have you joined the call? 9 (No response.) 10 MR. RICHARDS: Member McCullah? 11 (No response.) 12 MR. RICHARDS: Member Moore? 13 MR. MOORE: Good morning. Dana Moore. I am 14 the Vice President of Policy and Governmental Relations 15 for both the Texas Trucking Association and the Southwest 16 Movers Association. 17 Retired from the Texas Department of Public 18 Safety, where I retired after 37 years as a Sergeant in 19 the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Training Unit, where I 20 instructed commercial vehicle laws, regulations, DOT regulations, including household enforcement. 21 I am 22 already Presiding Officer on another DMV committee, so I 23 would prefer not to be, at least not the Presiding Officer 24 on this committee. 25 MR. RICHARDS: So can I count that as a maybe? ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

1 MR. MOORE: Well, maybe down the line. Not the 2 Chairman, if I put it that way. 3 MR. RICHARDS: Is that down the line in this 4 agenda, or down the line? 5 MR. MOORE: Down the line. 6 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. And we do have two 7 others, other than Presiding Officer. Member Moucka. 8 9 MR. MOUCKA: Yes, good morning. Chris Moucka with IMS Relocation. I am President and have been in the 10 11 business now -- we just celebrated our 30th year. 12 I look forward to working with everyone on the 13 Committee and am willing to be the Presiding Officer. 14 MR. RICHARDS: You are willing? Okay. Thank 15 you. 16 MR. MOUCKA: Yes. 17 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, sir. And lastly, Member Vinson. 18 19 MR. VINSON: Good morning. Christopher Vinson 20 with the Midlothian Police Department. I have 21 years as a police officer, about twelve of that specialized in 21 22 commercial enforcement. I would not be interested in the 23 Presiding Officer position. 24 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, Member Vinson, and 25 for your service, as well. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

Members, HGRAC will use Roberts Rules of Order 1 2 when conducting its meetings, as stated previously. To 3 take any action, you must first raise your hand or ask the 4 Presiding Officer, which is me at the moment, for the 5 right to speak on a matter. Once the Presiding Officer 6 grants you the floor, i.e., the right to speak, you must 7 make a motion, and another person must second that motion. 8 To make a motion to name someone to be the 9 Presiding Officer, the motion could be, for example, I 10 make a motion to name John Smith or Mary Smith to be the HGRAC Presiding Officer. You can even make a motion to 11 12 name yourself as the Presiding Officer. So that is an 13 option. 14 The second motion, a different member on the 15 Committee should say, I second. Or I second that motion. 16 As you know, I am sure, a person can't second their own 17 motion. So at this time, does anyone want to make a 18 19 motion to name one of the members to serve as HGRAC 20 Presiding Officer? 21 MR. BRISCOE: Chairman, excuse me. McCullah is 22 on the call, but I believe she is muted. 23 MR. MOORE: This is Member Moore. I'd like to 24 make a nomination. 25 MR. RICHARDS: I am sorry. Say it again? ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

MR. MOORE: This is Member Moore. I would like 1 2 to make a nomination. 3 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Go ahead, sir. MR. MOORE: I'd like to nominate Member Moucka. 4 5 I believe he said he was willing to be the Presiding 6 Officer, so I would like to nominate him. 7 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Member Moore nominates 8 Member Moucka to serve as the HGRAC Presiding Officer. 9 Is there a second to that motion? 10 MR. BRISCOE: I second. MR. RICHARDS: And you are who? 11 MR. BRISCOE: Briscoe. 12 13 MR. RICHARDS: Briscoe. Okay. Member Briscoe 14 provides a second. 15 Members, is there any further discussion on this motion and second? 16 17 (No response.) 18 MR. RICHARDS: Hearing none, I am going to go ahead and call for the vote. When I call your name, 19 20 members, state whether you vote to name Member Moucka as 21 Presiding Officer by stating your name, and then saying 22 yes or no. I think Member Andis is not on the call. 23 Member Baumgartner. 24 MR. BAUMGARTNER: Yes. Ron Baumgartner. 25 MR. RICHARDS: Member Briscoe. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

MR. BRISCOE: Yes. 1 2 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you. 3 Member Brooks. MS. BROOKS: Member Brooks votes yes. 4 5 MR. RICHARDS: Yes. Thank you. Member 6 Cisneros is not with us. 7 Member Crockett. 8 MR. CROCKETT: Crockett votes yes. 9 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you. 10 Member Ellis. MS. ELLIS: Member Ellis, yes. 11 12 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you. 13 Member Hertzberg. 14 MR. HERTZBERG: Member Hertzberg, yes. 15 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you. 16 And I understand that, Member McCullah, you 17 have joined us. How do you vote? 18 (No response.) 19 VOICE: I'm going to unmute her. She has called in. 20 21 VOICE: I unmuted her. She should be able --22 VOICE: She is unmuted. 23 MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Member McCullah, how do 24 you vote? 25 (No response.) ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

MR. RICHARDS: We'll come back to you in just a 1 2 second. 3 Member Moore. 4 MR. MOORE: Member Moore, yes. 5 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you. 6 Member Moucka. 7 MR. MOUCKA: Member Moucka, yes. MR. RICHARDS: Member Vinson. 8 9 MR. VINSON: Member Vinson, yes. 10 MR. RICHARDS: Thank you, sir. Member McCullah, coming back to you. How would 11 you vote? 12 13 (No response.) 14 VOICE: Maybe the member is having microphone 15 difficulties. 16 MS. MORIATY: She's unmuted, but we can't 17 hear --MR. RICHARDS: Okay. Member McCullah, we are 18 19 going to have to move on. You are unmuted, but we cannot 20 hear you in the meeting. 21 Members, the unanimous vote is for Member 22 Moucka to serve as Presiding Officer of the HGRAC Advisory 23 Committee. Congratulations, Member Moucka. 24 I am going to move on to Agenda Item 2C, 25 nominations and selection of the First Vice Chair. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

Advisory Committee members, this individual will act as 1 2 Presiding Officer when the Presiding Officer is not 3 available. 4 Does anyone want to make a motion to name 5 someone to be First Vice Chair? And please state your 6 name for the record when you make your motion. 7 MR. BAUMGARTNER: [inaudible] to be the 8 presiding officer? 9 MS. MORIATY: Briscoe and --10 MR. RICHARDS: Sure. We can do that. I think we have stated that Member Moore was a maybe, and Member 11 12 Briscoe was a yes to serve as an officer. 13 So, Members, take that in mind. And if I could 14 receive a motion, that would be great. Moore and Briscoe. 15 MR. BAUMGARTNER: Member Baumgartner 16 nominates --17 MR. RICHARDS: Okay, Member Baumgartner. And 18 who is your, what is your motion? 19 MR. BAUMGARTNER: I nominate or motion Member Briscoe. 20 21 MR. RICHARDS: Briscoe. Okay. Member 22 Baumgartner nominates Member Briscoe to serve as First 23 Vice Chair. 24 Is there a second? 25 MR. VINSON: Member Vinson. I will second. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342

MR. RICHARDS: Member Vinson seconds. 1 Any further discussion? 2 3 (No response.) 4 MR. RICHARDS: Hearing none. I am going to 5 call for the vote. 23	meeting, to give you an opportunity to discuss or ask
24	questions if you have any, and the time to think about it
25	before our next Advisory Committee meeting. Are there any
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1 questions at this time, on this agenda item? 2 (No response.) MR. RICHARDS: Hearing none, I will move on to 3 4 Agenda Item 2F, future meetings. At the current moment of 5 time, we do not have any future meetings on the HGRAC 6 schedule. 7 In the coming year, the Department plans to review Department's rules at the 43 Texas Administrative 8 9 Code Chapter 218, regarding motor carriers. The scope of 10 HGRAC's authority only covers certain portions of Chapter 11 218 regarding consumer protection for consumers using the 12 service of a motor carrier, who is transporting household 13 goods for compensation. Regardless of whether the 14 Department proposes amendments to the rules that fall 15 within the scope of HGRAC's authority, the Department will 16 submit certain rules to HGRAC for review, to make 17 recommendations on modernizing and streamlining those 18 rules. 19 When the Department ready to submit certain rules to the HGRAC for review and recommendations, we will 20 reach out to the Advisory Committee members in advance to 21 22 determine their availability, or your availability for a 23 future meeting. 24 The next agenda item is public comment. Tameka 25 has indicated we have no comments from the public. ON THE RECORD REPORTING (512) 450-0342
