## AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 INTERAGENCY COOPERATION CONTRACT RELATED TO COLLOCATION SERVICES AT THE AUSTIN DISASTER RECOVERY OPERATION CENTER

This Amendment Number 1 to the Interagency Cooperation Contract is entered into by and between the Department of Information Resources, an agency of the State of Texas (DIR) and the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) pursuant to the authority granted and in compliance with the provisions of the Interagency Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 771.

1. Contract, Section III, **BASIS FOR CALCULATING REIMBURSABLE COSTS** is hereby amended by adding the following to the end of the section:

Beginning on May 1, 2016, the reimbursable costs due from TxDMV associated with collocation of two (2) racks in the caged space 203.13 and 203.14 at ADROC is One Thousand and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) per month. Out of this amount, DIR will pay for all power and other utilities consumed by TxDMV.

- 2. Contract, Section IV, CONTRACT AMOUNT is hereby amended as follows: the cost of the contract shall not exceed Twenty Four Thousand (\$24,000) per 24-month period.
- 3. Contract, Section VI, TERM OF CONTRACT is hereby amended as follows: DIR and TxDMV hereby agree to extend the term of the Interagency Cooperation Contract for two (2) years through April 30, 2018.
- **4.** All other terms and provisions of the Interagency Cooperation Contract not specifically amended hereby remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict among the documents, the order of precedence shall be Amendment No. 1, then the Contract.

This Amendment No. 1 is executed to be effective as of the date of last signature.
