**TO:** All County Tax Assessor-Collectors

**SUBJECT:** Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Pilot Program for a Rear Window Registration Sticker

### PURPOSE:

To inform you of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's pilot program, effective October 22, 2000, for a rear window registration sticker designed to enhance sticker security and improve the registration process.

### DETAILS

The issuance of the new-style registration sticker, to be placed in a vehicle's rear window, is for those residents who renew, apply for a replacement registration plate or sticker or first time registration with an address in the Philadelphia area. This pilot program includes only passenger vehicles and light truck registration.


The new-style registration sticker is approximately 3-3/4" x 3-3/4" with a bright yellow background and contains the registration plate number and expiration date in large black print. The registration sticker has adhesive strip coverings and is placed inside the extreme lower left side (driver's side) corner of the rear window.

Until residents in the pilot program receive their new-style registration sticker in the mail, a separate Proof of Registration document is being mailed along with their registration card. The Proof of Registration temporarily will be placed inside the extreme lower left (driver's side) corner of the vehicle's rear window.

Dear Motor Vehicle Administrator:

This is to inform you that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is introducing a new-style registration sticker as part of a pilot program designed to enhance sticker security and improve Pennsylvania's overall registration process.

Effective October 22, 2000, residents who renew, apply for a replacement registration plate or sticker or first time registration with an address in the Philadelphia area will receive a new-style registration sticker from PennDOT. The pilot program includes passenger vehicle and lightweight truck registration only. Since this new-style registration sticker is placed in the vehicle's rear window, registered vehicle owners receiving the new-style registration sticker will no longer receive—or need—a registration sticker for their license plate.

The new-style registration sticker is approximately 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" with a bright yellow background and contains the registration plate number and expiration date in large black print. The new product also has adhesive strip coverings and is placed inside the extreme lower left (driver's side) corner of the vehicle's rear window.

Those included in the pilot program are also receiving an additional document along with their registration card called a Proof of Registration document. Since the new-style registration sticker is mailed separately, PennDOT has provided the Proof of Registration document as a convenience to customers whose Temporary Registration Permit or license plate sticker could expire before receiving their new-style registration sticker in the mail. The Proof of Registration can be placed on the vehicle temporarily and provides customers with a visible proof of registration that is required on a vehicle until the new-style registration sticker arrives. Individuals using the Proof of Registration will have the document placed inside the extreme lower left (driver's side) corner of the vehicle's rear window. This document is only a temporary document to be displayed until the new-style rear-window registration sticker arrives.

Please distribute this information to the appropriate members of your staff and your jurisdiction's law enforcement offices.
