TO: All County Tax Assessor-Collectors

SUBJECT: Revised Form 130-U, Application for Texas Certificate of Title

PURPOSE

To provide information regarding revised Form 130-U, Application for Texas Certificate of Title (copy attached).

DETAILS

The following revisions have been made to the front of the Form 130-U:

- Block 13 and 13a - Information regarding social security numbers or a Federal Tax ID Number has been combined in the upper right corner of the form so that when these numbers are masked for microfilm purposes, the names of applicants and the county of residence will not be obstructed. Former block 13a has been renumbered 13, and former block 13 is now a blank block.
- Block 14 -- Removed the words "Title Recipient" as a result of HB 642, which eliminated the Duplicate Original Title (refer to RTB# 109-01).
- A line has been added to separate the signature block and the Rights of Survivorship Ownership Agreement area for clarity.

Side Two

- First Box -- Modified information for clarity.
- Second Box -- Information regarding Right To Notice About Certain Information Laws and Practices was added, as a result of HB 1922 (refer to RTB#116-01).
- Fourth Box, second paragraph -- Added statement regarding certain diesel-powered vehicles being subject to surcharge, as a result of SB 005 (refer to RTB#113-01).
- Fourth Box -- Added information regarding inspection for vehicles previously registered and/or titled in another state or country, as a result of SB 005 (refer to RTB#113-01).
- Fourth Box, fifth paragraph, fifth line -- Deleted the words "and titled." Transportation Code, Section 548.256 no longer requires the Form VI-30-A for title only.

Please make this information available to dealers in your area so that those dealers who have software vendors producing this form for their use are aware of the changes.

The revised form will be distributed as soon as printing is complete. Upon receipt of the revised forms, please recycle any remaining old Forms 130-U and begin utilizing the revised version.
