Subject: Senate Bill 1353 – Legion of Valor and Former Prisoner of War License Plates

PURPOSE

To inform you of the provisions of SB 1353 which were enacted by the 77th Texas Legislature, 2001. This legislation will become effective September 1, 2001. A copy of the bill is attached.

DETAILS

SB 1353 allows persons who qualify for Legion of Valor or Former Prisoner of War license plates to register additional sets of license plates. The first set of plates will continue to cost \$3.00; however, the additional set(s) of plates will cost \$15 plus the regular registration fees prescribed for the additional vehicles.

ACTIONS

Second Set Of Legion of Valor or Former Prisoner of War License Plates:

Registrants who desire additional set(s) of Legion of Valor license plates should submit a written request to the Special Plates Branch in Austin. Registrants who desire additional set(s) of Former Prisoner of War license plates should complete a Form VTR-420. The applicant must mail either the written request or the Form VTR-420 to the Special Plates Branch in Austin. The applicant will need to send \$15.00 for each additional set(s) of plates. When approved, the applicant will receive notification that the plates are ready to be picked up at the county.

Renewals


For each additional set(s) of plates, the registrant will receive a renewal notice from the Special Plates Branch. The registrant must return the renewal notice and \$15.00 to the Special Plates Branch. The Special Plates Branch will mail a regular 3-part renewal for each additional set(s) of Legion of Valor and Former Prisoner of War to the registrant. The registrant must take proof of financial responsibility and pay the regular registration fees to the county to obtain the windshield validation sticker.

Attached is a revised Form VTR-420. Please make copies of this application as needed until you receive a stock of the revised forms from Huntsville and discard any previous versions you may have of this application. Registration manual revisions will be sent at a later date.
