Fee: \$5.30 – No registration fees

### Qualifications:

- Must be used solely for emergency disaster relief work.
- Vehicle must be owned and operated by non-profit disaster relief organizations; i.e. American Red Cross, Salvation Army, etc.

### Guidelines:

- Vehicles must be titled and are not exempt from title fees, except trailers weighing 4,000 pounds or less
- Owner must sign the application stating that the vehicle is used exclusively by the owner and solely for emergencies in disaster relief work.
- Application must be signed by an officer of the non-profit disaster relief organizations.
- Name of the non-profit organization must be displayed on each front door of the vehicle.

### Renewals:

- Notice sent 60 days prior to expiration.
- \$5.30 fee is submitted to the county tax office and a new plate is issued. (Validation sticker is not issued – month/year are on the plate).
- Must be renewed at the county tax office since a new plate is issued each year.
- If not renewing the plate, a general issue plate may be issued.
